GNAS Rules of Shooting and dress regulations in accordance with Rule 307 apply.

Compound archers will shoot at three-spot faces; all others at full-size faces. Two ends of practice will be held.

Fee: £9:00 for adults, £7:00 for juniors. Cheques payable to "Stourbridge Company of Archers".

Awards: 1st place Lady, Gentleman and Junior for each bow type. 2nd and 3rd places and classification medals according to entry. Veterans' trophy for highest score by gent over 65 or lady over 60 years of age.

If older juniors wish to shoot for senior awards, they should pay the senior entry fee and clearly state on the entry form that this is the case. Space behind the shooting line is limited and therefore only archers and officials will be allowed in the hall whilst shooting is in progress.

In view of the provisions of the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs at this event is required to register with the Organiser.

Stourbridge C of A disclaims any responsibility for damage to arrows.

GNAS membership cards must be shown on the day if requested.

Archers competing at Record Status tournaments will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.

Directions:



From M5 Junction 4, take the A38 towards Birmingham. After half a mile, turn off left immediately after passing under a bridge into Gannow Road. The entrance to the school is across the mini-roundabout at the end.

Coming from Birmingham on the A38, turn left then right onto Whettybridge Lane, which will take you over the A38. Then turn right onto School Road and

look out for the entrance just before the mini-roundabout.
